I don't know whether I will also receive some of the books I've put in for by that date or not, but probably will receive a few. And in that case will see that you get one of them.

I think at this time I should place my final order to the publisher for the books. As I recall, you still want five copies even though you will receive one from the "anapums and I when we visit Seattle. By ordering them with my author's discount, I can let you have them for \$4.80 each.

Don't forget that I will send a copy to Lee Yost.

If you will write me how you want any of the other books inscribed besides the one I will personally inscribe for you, and get Puck Hyah Toot's thumb print affixed to it, it would also be wise to send that at this time. Then I won't get bogged down in a lot of last minute rush when I will be snowed under.

Working out this book tour and writing letters to reviewers, etc. has been a job of sizeable consequence and there are a thousand and one other things to do. Some things can't be done at this time, and I'm afraid they will all come together.

Starting Oct. 6 in taking our tour will bring us to Portland, Tacoma, Maryhill Museum of Fine Arts and then to Seattle Thursday and Friday, October 11 and 12. The book dept. of Frederick and Nelson has had to change plans. I'm to be at Rhodes Oct. 11, which is one of the Carl Wilson outlets, and that is just as well as he has outlets all over and it would be preferable to concentrate on him, because of the number of stores involved.

Don't fall off the dock during Seafair. Hope your work is going well throughout the Indian country.
