It is hereby directed, that all unexpended balances, if any, in your hands, under appropriation "Contingencies Indian Department, 1880", that will not be needed for expenditure up to and including June 30<sup>th</sup> next, be immediately deposited to the credit of the United States, in the nearest U. S. Depository, the original ~~and~~ duplicate certificates of deposit to be mailed direct to this office, without delay.

Disbursing officers of this Bureau are directed to reduce expenditures chargeable to above appropriation, to the lowest possible limit, in order that no deficiency may be created during the current fiscal year.
