

" The Public Library over Lombard and Horsley's furniture store contains 500 volumes of well selected literature and is open Wednesday and Saturday afternoons and evenings. The fee for a life membership is one dollar and the books cost 5 cents per week rental; or the charge for books may be commuted by paying \$2.50 per year. At present the membership is about 80. All who are interested in good books should join the library and help to make it a success. "
