

Notes about the manuscript

This manuscript documents board meetings of a circulating library that was organized in North Yakima, WA in 1891. Circulating libraries were private clubs that charged membership dues. The record begins with the 1896 articles of incorporation of the Yakima Library Association and continues through April 21, 1904, when the Association was dissolved and all library property was transferred to the City of Yakima, which in turn established the Yakima Public Library.

In 1904 this manuscript was half-bound (meaning it has leather on the spine and corners) over paperboard covered with a marbled paper. The pages were manually numbered and the edges of the text block were marbled after the manuscript was bound. This style of binding was commonly used in the early 20th century for government and business records.

The incorporators, with the exception of O. A. Fechler, together with other ladies and gentlemen who are charter member of this Association met at North Cakenia Hakima County, Wash. on the 16th day (April 1896, att 4. 30 P. be presented. The decretary then read the constitution and by laws. Mrs. Snively moved that the constitution and by laws as read be adopted. Mr. M. F. Prosser seconded the motion, the chairman but the motion and it was unanimously carried. The chairman appropried that the constitution and by-laws just adopted, would be spread upon the minutes of the meeting, and be the constitution and by laws of this Association, until saltered or amended as provided. On motion of Mrs. Ida B. Sharkey the meeting proceed ed to elect a board of Trustees, and the Sollowing mumbers were duly elected Mrs. Emma V. Morrison, Mrs. Carrie B. Thelkerson, Mrs. W.F. It shall be the duty of the decretary to keep minites of the proceed ingo of all meetings of the Board of Trastels and of the Association; to keep the accounts of the Association; to receive all money paid in for mem bership, fines and dries, and to pay it over promply to the Treasurer, taking a receipt therefor; to submit a report at the regular meetings of the Board of Trustees; to countersign and make entry of all money orders drawn upon the Oreasurer; to have the care of all papers and documento belonging to the Anocia tion, and to give notice of all regular and special meetings of the Board of Trustees and of the Association.

Sec. VI_ Treasurer. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive all modery

donated for the general purposes of the Association, all money paid over by the Secretary, to pay it out on the orders of the President, counter organd by the Secretary; to keep an adecount of all receipts and expenditures, and to submit a report at the regular meetings of the Board of Trustees, and at the arrhal meeting of the Association.

Sec VII Sife Members. It shall be the duty of Life Members to elect at the arrival arreiting of the Association, a board of Trustees and a Librarian.

Article IV. Meetings of the Association. The annal meeting of the Association shall be held on the third Thursday of April. Deven members shall constitute a gnorum. The annal meeting of the Board of Trustees for the election of officers and for the transaction of other business, shall be held on the third Thursday of April. Four members shall constitute a grown. The regular meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held on the third Thursday of April, July, October and January of each year! Special meetings may be realled by the President of by four members of the Board of Trustees or by seven dirembers of the Association.

Article V Amendments.

Association by two-thirds vote of
the members present, notice of such
proposed amendment having first
been given in writing to each mem
ber ten days previous to such meling, and a copy of the proposed

in the Library for the same length
of time.

Obertion of the Board of Trustees:

(It the first meeting of the Association to be held on the third Thursday of April 1896 a Board of Trustees shall be elected in the following manner: Mominations shall be made seperately and recorded by the Secretary when the mominations dre closed. The Secretary Shall read the names of all the northinees recorded,

and the Association shall ballot for the same, each member voting for six nominees, and the six names receiving the highest number of votes shall be

declared to be elected. The Board of Trustees shall their decide by lot which three of their minuter shall serve for one year. At the annal meetings thereafter only three members shall be voted for to serve as trustees, and they shall hold office for the term of two years.

Article II

Sife members shall pay fifteen cents monthly or one dollar per year for the use of books. Associate members shall pay seventy five cents granterly for the use of books. All dues shall be payable in advance.

Article III Library





Notes about the manuscript

Pages 47 and 48 have been removed from the original manuscript. Meeting notes from the summer meeting of 1898 are not included in the manuscript. The text on page 46 (Spring, 1898) breaks off and does not connect to what is written on page 49 (Fall, 1898), so there is no way of confirming what, if any, material may be missing. A strip of the missing leaf is caught in the gutter between the pages and shows that the page was torn out.

Removing pages from bound manuscripts was how writers removed ink spills and smudges. Removing the original page and rewriting the text or omitting it altogether was also a method used to edit the text.
