Dear Frank:

I received a call today from the people who are building the dam.

We should leave early in the morning, by 6 or 7 o'clock and can go in the one car, my car. If Alba S. wants to come, that will be fine and he should bring Indian clothes too.

We will leave from the office. I will have things ready there so I can go

Be sure and let me know, right away that you have ~~not~~ received this message and are seeing that the word gets around to Rex, Bobby etc. I suppose Johnny T. will be too sick to go on a long trip like that.

It is very good the way things are working out and this is just what we have been working for. It will mean much in the future. I will explain that on the way up.
