Mr. Jackson (for himself and Mr. Magnuson) (by request) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs

A B I L L

To authorize a per capita distribution of \$350. from funds arising from judgments in favor of any of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3. That the funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United
4 States to the credit of the Colville Tribe, San Poelils-
5 Nespelem Tribe, Okanogan Tribe, Methow Tribe, and Lake
6 Tribe (certain constituent groups of the Confederated Tribes
7 of the Colville Reservation) that were appropriated to pay
8 a judgment of the Indian Claims Commission dated March
9 1, 1960, in docket numbered 181, and the funds which may
10 be deposited in the Treasury of the United States to the

1 credit of the said constituent groups of any other constituent
2 groups of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation
3 to pay any judgments arising out of proceedings presently
4 pending before the Indian Claims Commission in dockets
5 numbered 161, 179, 181-A, 181-B, 181-C, 222, and 224,
6 and the interest on said judgments, after payment of attorney
7 fees and expenses, shall be credited to the account of the Con-
8 federated Tribes of the Colville Reservation and the Secretary
9 of the Interior is authorized and directed to make a per
10 capita distribution from such funds of \$350 to each enrolled
11 member of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reserva-
12 tion. Any part of such funds distributed per capita to the
13 members of the tribes shall not be subject to Federal or
14 State income tax.
