Five critical years in the life of Steve, the only son of Christine and Stephen of "They came to a River".

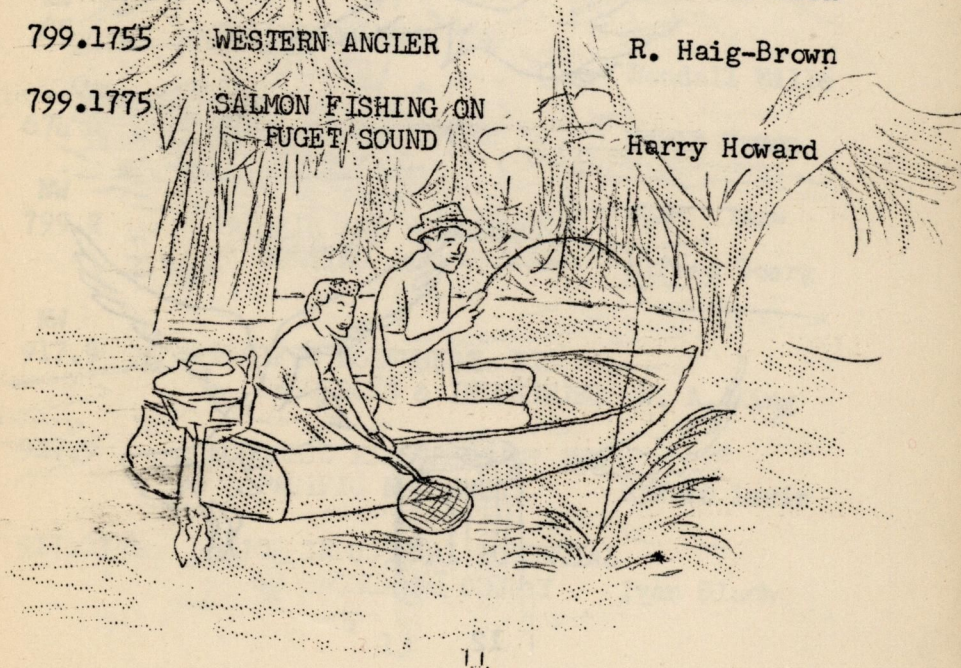
