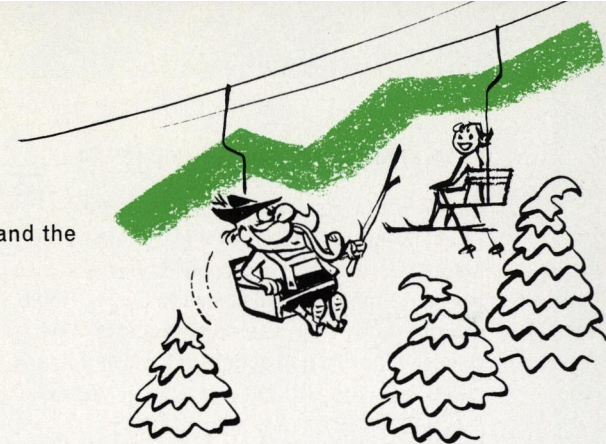
## MAGIC MILE CHAIR LIFT

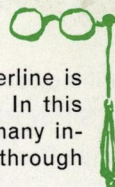

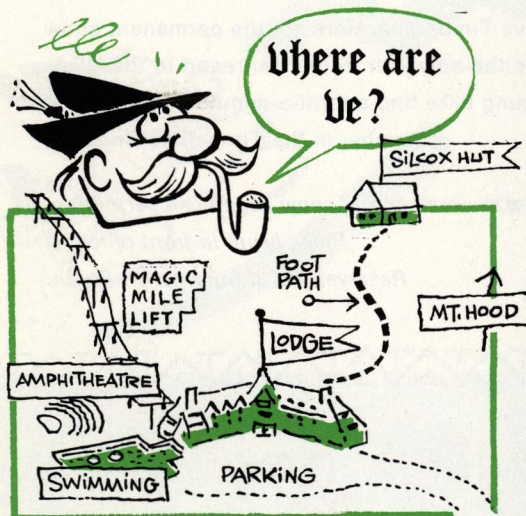
The lodge also welcomes conventions and group meetings or banquets at special rates.

Built by the government in 1937, Timberline is truly a masterpiece built by craftsmen. In this Castle-Above-The-Clouds you'll find many interesting things to look for as you walk through the lodge.

1. Hand-carved newel posts on the stairways.
2. A valuable collection of paintings by C. E. Price.
3. The world's largest fireplace.
4. Ponderosa pine beams and structural members.
5. Hand made furniture (the original).
6. Hand woven fabrics especially designed for Timberline.
7. The outdoor Amphitheatre seating 250 persons.
8. The Crystal Pool holding 118,000 gallons of water and 12½ feet deep, with heated walkways to melt snows.
