THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 25th day of March, 1919 by and between Minnie Boon Brown and Lawrence Brown her husband, parties of the first part, and L.T.Parker, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That the party of the second part agrees to plow and prepare for seed, to furnish seed and plant to barley all of the farmable land on the east half of the southwest quarter of section sixteen, township ten north range twenty E.W.M. during the season of 1919, and to care for, and harvest the said crop and to deliver to the parties of the first part in the field as threshed one third of all the grain so grown and raised on the said premises during the said season of 1919, free and clear of all expense, excepting the said parties of the first part are to pay for one third of the threshing and to furnish sacks for their one third portion thereof.

The said parties of the first part agree that the said party of the second part may farm the said land during the said season of 1919 as above provided and to receive the said one third portion of the said grain for the use of the said land during the said time.

The party of the second part is to have two thirds of the pasture and the parties of the first part one third after the said crops are harvested and removed from the said premises.

This agreement shall only exist and be in force during the farming season of 1919.
