

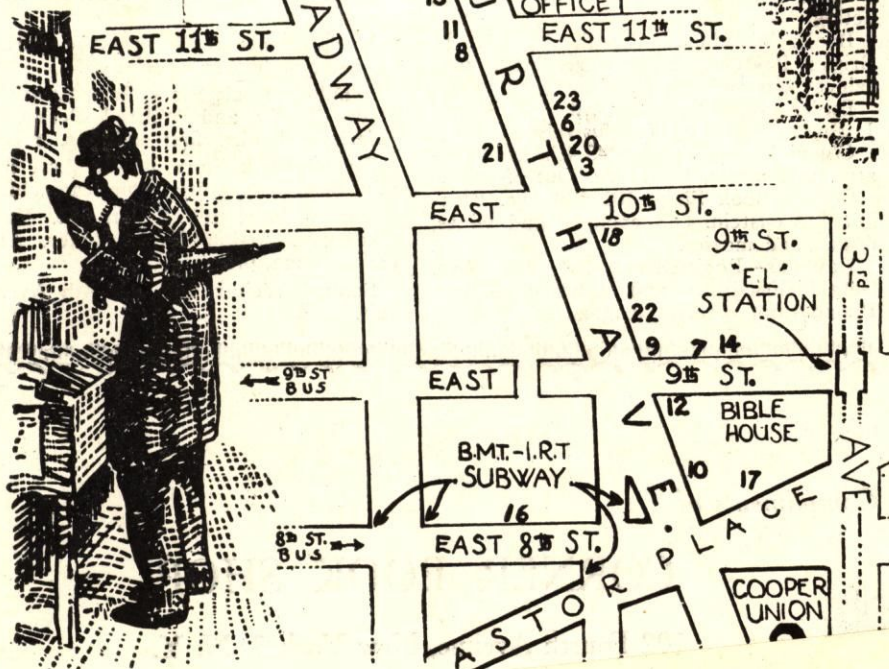
The following transportation reaches Book Center (Fourth Avenue) in New York City:

IRT—Grand Central Station—Woodlawn Jerome Train to 14th Street Station or Astor Place Station.
BMT—Pennsylvania Station—8th Street Station and one street east to Book Row (Fourth Avenue).
8th AVENUE SUBWAY—4th Street - N. Y. University Station and Crosstown Bus to Book Row (Fourth Avenue)
BUSES MARKED MADISON or LEXINGTON AVENUE takes you through the heart of Book Row.
BUS MARKED BROADWAY—North or South (between 8th and 13th St.) is one street west of Book Row (Fourth Avenue)
