Dear Sir:

Enclosed is half of the typescript of Microcopy Records of the Washington Superintendency of Indian Affairs, 1853-1874. Letters from Employees Assigned to the Nez Perce and Umatilla Agencies January 24, 1856-May 15-1864. National Archives, Washington, 1945. No. 5 Roll 21.

These are rough copies and have been scanned and tabbed to facilitate determination of their contents.

Again I suggest that rather than be made Addendum to any MS-I, Yakima, Palouse, etc. they would be most useful if viewed in chronological order with other microcopies.

They contain some Wanapum or Priest Rapids information, Marked "Important," as well as numerous Yakima and perhaps some Palouse information.

The other half of the typescript is sent under separate wrapper.

It is designated: Second half Microcopy Roll No. 5, 21. It is sent separately because it concerns mainly Nez Perce material, mines, reservation boundary, etc.
