When I get a break, I'll see what I can work out on addresses for the Pasco-Richland area. I might not have as good a listing there as for Walla Walla, Spokane, etc. because of the type of population, and the White Bluffs people, the "evacuees" also move around between the two cities.

I have been trying to check on these addresses since I think many of them will be returns, but they will be good if I can connect. I've attended some of the picnics at Prosser and they know the Indians in my book intimately and have been looking forward to it.

I've a strong suspicion that before publication time and when you get to working on the book through contacts in the store, you will be increasing your advance order, but that will take care of itself.

It occurred to me that perhaps you'd like to have circulars with your store imprints on them (both stores on the same circular) I can arrange for this if you wish and at no cost of course. Caxtons will publish them for you providing 1,000 are requested. That might be a trifle high but I think it would be worthwhile. You could use them in the stores and in material mailed out. They would be delivered about 90 days before publication. Circular is enclosed if you care to list proper addresses or way you wish imprint and return to me
