PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFULS "SHY"? REFUSE TO STATE POSITIONS ON ISSUES OF THE DAY

To sweeten the jackpot still further for the munitions lobby, our very un-Christian Catholic "boy" wonder even goes to the extent of declaring "Berlin is worth an atomic war" ... little realizing what such a war would mean to our people and to the peoples of the world; with hundreds of millions dead, untold horror, suffering and sorrow; destruction and devastation everywhere, and possibly the obliteration of mankind from our planet earth. IS THERE A GOOD DEMOCRAT OR REPUBLICAN WHO WANTS SUCH A PRESIDENT?

HUMPHREY, an able double-talker is much the superior to the above named "bunch" Quite shifty, if he thought he could be elected President by being friendly with the Russians he would be in Moscow every weekend: and quite the opposite is also true. With great powers of leadership, he forgets that he is in a position of giving positive leadership and that it is his job to give leadership, instead of waiting for it to come to him. Likewise he forgets that being a public servant means working in the best interests of the people and leaving it at that. Since humanity has a way of rewarding its good servants, the rest would take care of itself.

Every honest man knows that peace and disarmament is to the best interests of the people and of all mankind; yet as Chairman of the Senate Sub-Committee on Disarmament, Humphrey straddles the fence; double-talks his way around, telling one group that he's for disarmament, and another that "we must get on the ball and increase our defenses" ... which is only another way of appeasing the munitions merchants and bankers—who profit from armaments—since "more defenses" means more armaments and more profits to the small Wall Street group—the 6 tenths of one per cent of the people who own and control 84% of the wealth of the nation (according to Senator Richard Richards), and who have a stranglehold of debt on our people of over \$1,000 billion.

Going down the line of prospective hopefuls, Wayne Morse would be the choice of many liberals, but it has been said that "he has ent a chance, because he is too honest" and because of that he is the most unpopular man in the Senate, who "could nt get a Resolution passed in Congress commemorating mothers on Mothers Day."

And so it goes, the political bosses do not want honest men in top positions whom they cannot control, but how about the people? What do we want? Do we, or dont we want an honest man for President? Certainly we dont want a stooge of the oil, munitions and banking interests who will continue to tax the hell out of us, keep our children in perpetual bondage and humanity in the peril of atomic war.

Mention has also been made of Walter Reuther as a possible Democratic candidate. As a foremost labor leader in the country and also of the CONFERENCE ON ECONOMIC PROGRESS—an organization with a very fine program—the opportunity has been wide open for a candidate from Labor to open an entering wedge into the political arena, but it seems that Walter is too timid, too shy and too reluctant to make the sacrifice and grasp out at the opportunity of projecting a fight for political leadership which could carry the tremendous weight of labor behind it; uniting labor politically and making it the dominate political force in the nation ... such as the British labor movement has done.

Would he but strike out with the program of the CONFERENCE ON ECONOMIC PROGRESS, surely he could open up a sizable dent in the political structure of our country. The Program calls for: FULL EMPLOYMENT; a national economy of \$600 billion annually; an annual increase of \$104 billion in wages and salaries; \$33 billion increased incomes for small business & professional workers; annual increased income to farmers of \$10.5; annual increased income of \$2,000 per family in consumer buying power; and for doubling the Social Security.

But since Walter prefers to play "footsie", "hard-to-get" and delves only in "behind-the-scenes" politics, refusing to give labor the political leadership it is entitled to, thus forcing labor into the background politically, while its opponents run roughshod passing anti-labor laws in Congress ... well, as they say, "he who hesitates is lost", and so is the political power of labor ... dorment, divided and decaying; with 45 million of our people--mostly workers--NOT VOTING: enough to elect any man to any office in the land, and to throw out all of its enemies from office.

Others in the Presidential line-up who probably would guide us on a trend of world peace and back to the Roosevelt course and sanity, would be Adlai Stevenson or Pat Brown. If nominated, these men would hold out hope for the Democratic Party, for the United States and the world.

However, going back to the Roosevelt days is not enough, and in the absence of a prominent Democratic candidate bearing a real advanced people's program in keeping with our modern atomic age, which the people rightly deserve, it is imperative that such a candidate with such a program be found and placed on the California Presidential Primary ballot, and if possible in other states with Presidential primaries ... to determine to what extent the people are ready to accept and support such a standard bearer.

Rising out of the horizon like the sunshine of a new day emerges such a candidate, bearing a dynamic program and offering a unique type of leadership which eclipses all others. Unannounced, unheraled and "blacked-out" by the controlled news media, this dynamic figure boldly proclaims a program for the people unheard of before. Like a modern Moses, ready and willing to lead the people out of the vortex of their self-imposed wilderness, this great leader General Herbert C. Holdridge (Retired) offers a program fitting for our modern times, which mankind must either accept or be out of tune with the universal process and remain on the "brink" of banishment and disaster.

Although well known to many throughout the country, General Holdridge is still unknown to the great mass of the American people. He is as fearless a fighter for truth and justice, and the rights of man as has ever appeared on the American political scene. He is now offering his services and a new type of dynamic leadership which many of our more intelligent and honest people are clamoring for. At present, his may be a "voice in the wilderness", but given time and the opportunity—with the help of the rank and file of the people—his voice will be as thunder crashing against the walls of evil and corruption, behind which operates the invisible government, selfish and arrogant, issuing orders to its secondary "branch" of rubber-stamp puppets in Washington to continue their mis—management of the people's affairs.

A year ago no one imagined that Castro-with his small band-would suddenly descend from his mountain hideout a few days hence to be acclaimed a conquering hero and liberator of his people from the clutches of the monetary dictatorship, after a bloodless revolution.

With disgust, dissatisfaction and resentment mounting everywhere at the everrising taxes and living costs, due mainly to corruption, incompetency and disintrigation of our political leadership in their failure to promote the general welfare, there are signs that an upsurge of the people--long overdue--is
now imminent, and just as suddenly a Castro type bloodless revolution (of the
ballot box) may engulf the entire country; overthrowing incompetent politicans
who fail in their responsibility of making government of, by and for the people, WORK FOR THE PEOPLE ... replacing them with honest, intelligent and courageous men who will usher in new methods and ideas of freedom and democracy-political, economic, social and spiritual, which our modern age of atomic
