COAT—The Swallowtail. OVERCOAT—Cape, Paletot, Chesterfield. WAISTCOAT—Single-breasted of white silk or pique. TROUSERS—Same material as coat. HAT—High silk with felt band or silk ribbon. SHIRT—Plain white linen with cuffs attached. COLLAR—Poke, wing or straight-stander. CRAVAT—White, plain or figured. GLOVES—White. JEWELRY—Links and studs of pearl or moonstone. BOOTS—Patent leather pumps, or patent leather button shoes with black kid tops.

EVENING DRESS (Informal).

COAT—Tuxedo, black or Oxford. OVERCOAT—Chesterfield or Great Coat. WAISTCOAT—Black or black and white linen, or silk. TROUSERS—Same material as coat. HAT—Black derby. SHIRT—White, plain or pleated bosom and cuffs attached. COLLAR—Wing or fold. CRAVAT—Black or gray silk. GLOVES—Gray suede or silk. JEWELRY—Gold or jeweled links and studs. BOOTS—Patent leather or gun metal pumps or button shoes.






