Sir:

The Office is in receipt of a letter from the Agent at Yakima Agency, dated October 24, 1892, in which he states that some of the pupils who attended the reservation school last year, have been taken to your contract school by their parents.

You are requested to return to the government school, at once, all the pupils enrolled at your school this year who were in attendance at the government reservation school last year. In this connection your attention is called to Article 1, Paragraph 2, of your contract, which forbids you to receive pupils who were in attendance at other schools during the twelve months preceding date of contract without special authority therefor from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
