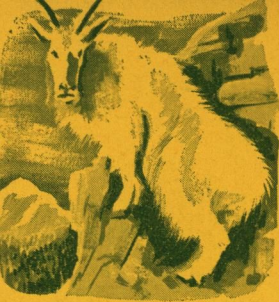

Lake Chelan

In North Central Washington in the very heart of the unbelievably beautiful Cascade

Mountains, lies Lake Chelan, the "Switzerland of America." Winding for 49 miles through snow-capped peaks, the lake reflects in its clear depths some of the most breath-taking scenery and some of the most rugged country in the United States. The lake itself, varying from one-half to two miles in width, is one of nature's most magnificent "believe-it-or-nots." Its sparkling surface is more than 1,100 feet above the level of the ocean and its bottom more than 400 below it. The lake's deep blue color bespeaks its great depth and clarity.

At the head of the lake is Stehekin Ranger district, considered to be the most rugged area in the States. Deer, bear and mountain goats abound in the forests, and silver trout and other game fish teem in the waters of the lake and its many tributaries.

Golden West Lodge is at the very head of the lake. Here, where glacier-fed waterfalls cascade into the blue water and fir, pine and cedar scent the air, is a remote, peaceful vacationland for all who love beautiful scenery, boating and natural surroundings. Your vacation begins the moment you step aboard the boat or plane to travel the length of Lake Chelan to Golden West Lodge.

How to get to Lake Chelan

Although far-removed from the bustle of the workaday world, Lake Chelan is readily accessible by car, train, or plane. The Golden West Lodge itself at the head of Lake Chelan can be reached only by boat or plane.

BY AUTO:

From the Coast: Travel over Snoqualmie and Blewett Passes or Stevens-Sunset Highway to Wenatchee, then to the town of Chelan at the foot of the lake.

From the east: By Coulee City and Waterville to Chelan.

BY TRAIN: Take the Great Northern Railway to Wenatchee and a bus to the foot of the lake where you board a fast cruiser to travel 49 miles to Golden West Lodge.

BY PLANE: You can now fly to Golden West Lodge from any airport in the United States. Fly United Airlines to Seattle-Tacoma or Spokane. West Coast Airlines will pick up passengers at Boeing Field in Seattle or Geiger Field in Spokane and fly them directly to Wenatchee. By calling or writing Chelan Airways, Chelan phone No. 1, Chelan, Washington, you can have them meet you at Wenatchee or Chelan and fly you to the Golden West Lodge. By arranging in advance you can reach the Lodge in the shortest possible time.

BY BOAT: The Lake Chelan Boat Company operates regularly scheduled passenger runs from Chelan to Stehekin. Transportation is furnished from the boat landing at Stehekin to the Lodge.

Transportation rates may be had upon request.

Things to Do . . .

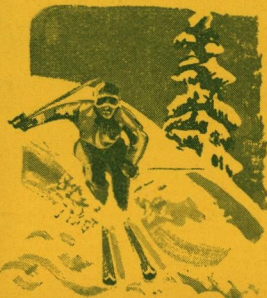
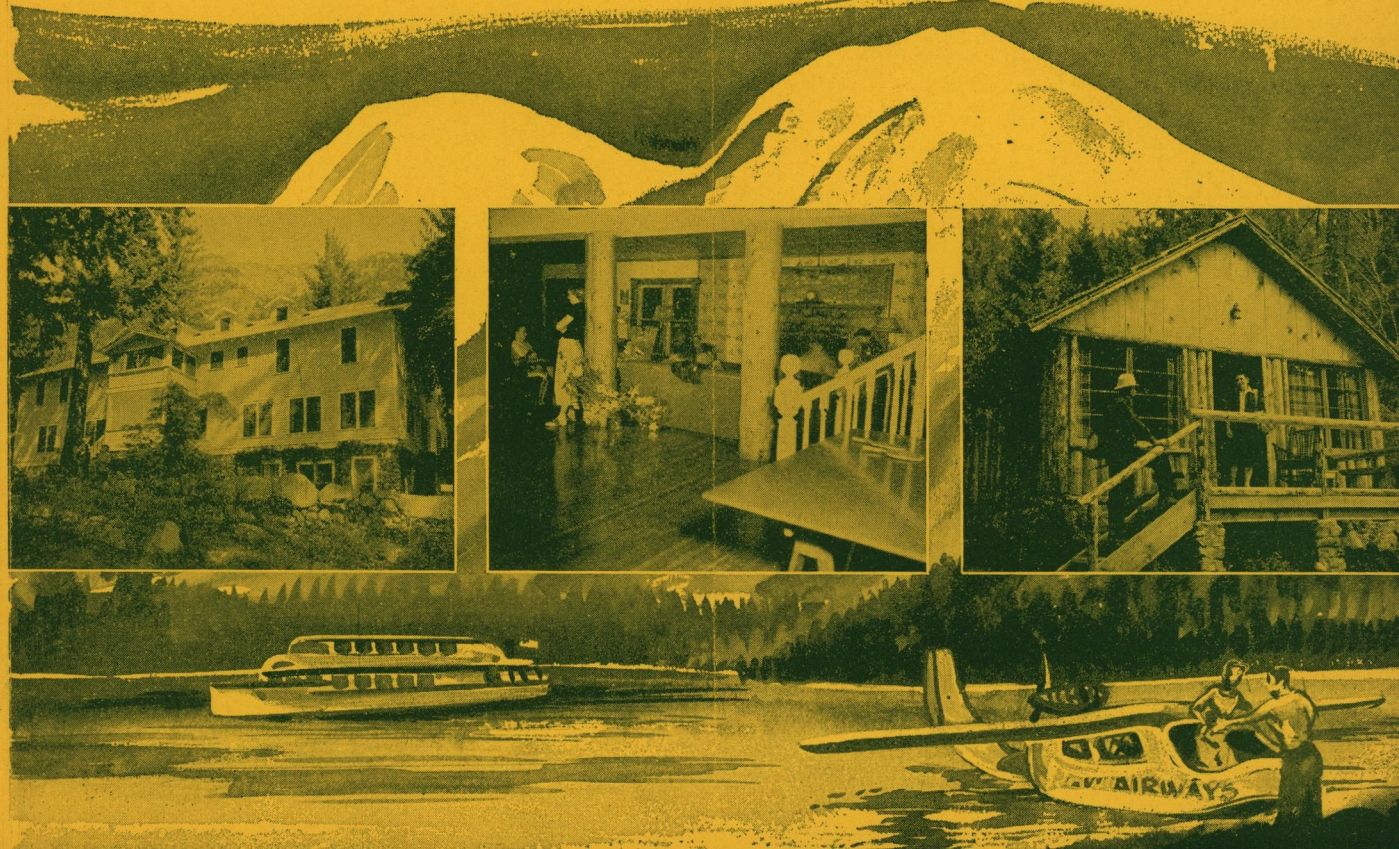
There are many activities available at Golden West Lodge. Beside the usual resort activities such as dancing, billiards, table tennis, shuffle board, archery, horseshoe pitching and cards, there are those activities which the surroundings on Lake Chelan make more pleasurable than elsewhere.

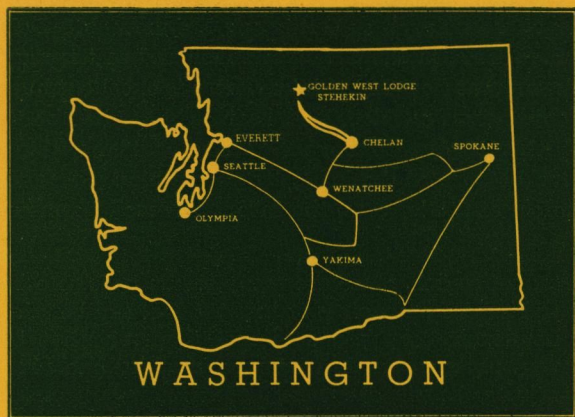
There is fine fishing on the lake for silver trout, and an abundance of Cutthroat, Rainbow and Dolly Varden trout in the Stehekin River and in the many streams that flow in the lake. There is excellent hunting in season for deer and bear in the wilds of the Stehekin region. Each year deer are taken within a short distance of the lodge by people who prefer the comfort of the lodge to the inconvenience of a mountain camp.

And, of course, there are many scenic trips to other lakes, streams and points of interest that can be taken by horseback, jeep, plane or boat. Your vacation becomes truly memorable when you combine one of the beautifully scenic excursions with fishing in one of the 13 lakes within a short distance of the lodge.

Golden West Lodge has a backyard ski area and many snowshoe trails to provide recreation for the winter time enthusiast. The ski area is lighted for night-time, as well as day time skiing fun.

The winter time beauty and activities of Golden West Lodge are experiences that will be both pleasant and memorable. Rainbow Falls, which freezes over, has blue ice and also glimpses of blue snow may be





seen in the Stehekin Valley. Deep winter snows bring the mountain goat and deer down along the lakeshore where they may be seen from the passenger boat and seaplane.

The combination of magnificent scenery and exciting activities make a vacation at Golden West Lodge an unforgettable pleasure.

Accommodations . . .

The Lodge: Center of all activity at Golden West Lodge is the lodge itself. Here in the spacious lobby with its massive native stone fireplace and inviting circle of davenports and soft lounge chairs friends meet, relax after a run-filled day and plan for other exciting days to come.

There are 22 comfortable guest rooms in the lodge, all equipped with hot and cold running water. All rooms have been newly furnished and the beds have downysoft innercoil mattresses and box springs. Rooms with private bath are available, and all rooms have conveniently located showers and tubs.

Cabins: For those who prefer, there are new sleeping and housekeeping cabins. Built of lodge-pole pine with shakes on the roof, the cabins sport beautifully finished knotty-pine interiors designed to give a maximum of homelike comfort with a minimum of work. All cabins are electrically lighted and completely furnished with bedding, dishes and linens. The convenient kitchens have wood ranges, hot water tanks, sinks and built-in cabinets, and there is a shower, toilet and wash bowl in each cabin. There are sleeping accommodations with innerspring mat-

tresses for four persons. There are also three cabins with bunk beds and kitchen-equipped cabins without bath that have sleeping accommodations for from two to four persons.

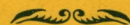
