Haven't seen him but suspect it has not been held or was held when I was in California. I am looking forward to attending it when it is held and I suspect that some Palouse descendants, possibly overlooked informants, may be on hand then. If so, and I am there, I will be glad to introduce them to any staff or department attendant, as chances are I will know them. This would not be entirely true of some of the Palouse descendants on the Colville Reserve.
