The Yakima Indian Agency has been obtained for Toppenish, and the site has been selected. It is now important to get busy immediately to formulate definite plans for immediate action to carry out the pledge made on behalf of the Toppenish Commercial Club. The subscription pledge, a copy of which is enclosed, suggests that the plan will be carried out by the organization of a joint stock or holding company, or by a trustee arrangement as the majority of the contributors shall determine and that is one question to be settled at this time, and there are many other details of importance to be worked out.
