FATHER JOSEPH CARUANA, S.J.

Joseph Caruana was born on the Island of Malta, at Valetta on August 28, 1836. He was educated at the Jesuit College on his native island and at the Roman College. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 18, 1859, when only twenty-two and a half years of age. Because of his youth, a dispensation from the Holy Father was required to permit his ordination. A year later, on July 15, 1860, he entered the Society of Jesus, and immediately volunteered for the Indian missions of the Rocky Mountains in the New World. He pronounced his first vows as a Jesuit at Santa Clara, California, in 1862, and was sent to St. Ignatius Mission in Montana to begin his life work. His priestly life from that day to his death was spent in one or the other of the many Indian missions in the care of his Society in the Pacific Northwest. He was the first Jesuit at the Ahtanum Mission in 1870, becoming superior of the Mission when others were sent to assist him. He remained in that capacity until 1880, when he was transferred to Colville, but we find him again in Yakima from 1883 to 1885. After a long and fruitful missionary life he died at Desmit, Idaho, on October 29, 1918, at the age of 77. His memory is perpetuated in Yakima by two Catholic societies that are named for him: The Caruana Court, Catholic Daughters of America, and the Father Joseph Caruana Assembly, Fourth Degree, Knights of Columbus.
