



We were wondering when we would be challenged over some of the materials in our booklet, "Highways to History." Nevertheless, we are guite surprised by your very direct question concerning the identity of Chief Kamiakin, and the photo of him in our publication.

The photograph which we list as Chief Kamiakin came from Mrs. Ibbotson, a member of the staff of the Washington State Historical Society at Tacoma. Unfortunately, Click, we are not qualified here to determine whether or not she is right. We will pursue your question and let you know what we can uncover. At any rate, it will be very interesting to see.

You might be interested to know that there has been considerable controversy over the location and wording of our historical markers above Wishram on Sign Route 830 on the Columbia River. In an effort to solve the dilemma, we referred the matter to Mr. Bruce LeRoy, director of the museum at Tacoma. Bruce wrote back the following reply: "I'll be damned if I know."

All of this reminds me of the city editor who told me once that there are three sides to every story -- "yours, mine, and the facts." And as I grow older I find that it is increasingly more difficult to get the facts.
