I have been taking
listening in a case referred here
by the Land Office at Vancouver
and have had occasion to
examine the deces of the Court
at Yakama in the case of U S vs
Frank Taylor, and went in person
and examined the Indians land
and fishing at Tumwater and
find the Culwash trail fenced
up with a wire fence in 4
different places and the
Indians fenced off and ex-
cluded from their fishing
grounds almost entirely
as Simpson can explain to
you which is a clear viola-
tion of the injunction and decree

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of the Yakama agent. Something
ought to be done and at once
to enforce the provisions of that
injunctive and decree. and to
perpetually open those fisheries
to the Indians and keep the
trail open to them. We are
presenting the case now
for the Indians to hold 160 acres
of land over there at the sugges-
tion of Gen Gordon & Col T. D. Lang
and would if necessary
take testimony and have
that decree enlarged so as to
give the Indians at least half
a mile from the river back along
the entire length of the fisheries
with a good open trail to them
