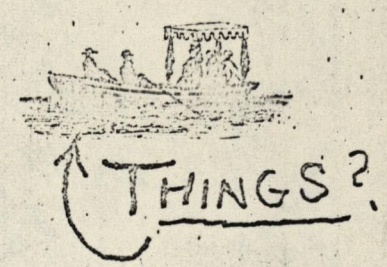
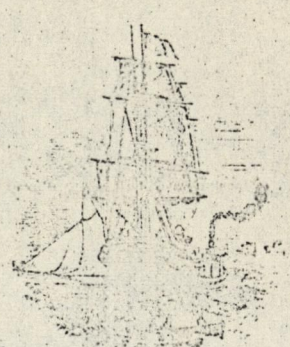
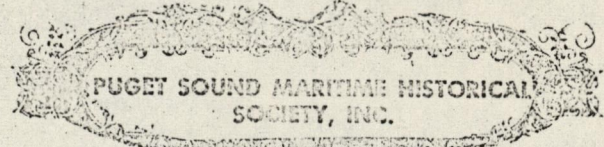


STEAMBOATS?
