and having filed with me a bond in the penal sum of
TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS, with S. Lauber, J. Reed + P. Bounds of
Yakima Co. Wash.

as sureties, conditioned, as required by law, for the faithful observance of all the laws and regulations provided for the government of trade and intercourse with Indian tribes, and having satisfied me, as required by law, that she is a citizen of the United States, and of good moral character, is hereby authorized to carry on the business of trading with the said tribe at the above-named place for the term of **ONE YEAR** from the 29 day of Dec., eighteen hundred and ninety-one and to keep in employ thereat the following-named person in the capacity affixed to name

I am satisfied, from the testimonials which have been placed in my hands, sustain a fair character and fit to be in the Indian country.

This license is granted upon the further express condition that the said Josephine Lillie in accepting the same waives all right and privilege which she might otherwise have to any claim against the Government of the United States for losses or damages, or both, which may result from the depredations of Indians during the continuance of this license and pending the removal of her effects from the Indian country on the expiration or revocation of the same.
