The Colonel's noxt assignment was thet of instructor at the Infentry School at Fort Bonning, Georgia, fron 3 Januery 1947 to 10 Nove $\begin{aligned} & \text { ber } 1950 \text {. }\end{aligned}$ This was followod by duty as 4 th Infontry Division artillory 53 from 11 Noveribor 1950 to 14 lley 1951. He then served as en instructor at the Cormand and General Staff College, Fort Leevenworth, Kanses, until November 1954.

Fron Deconbor 1954 until lugust 1956, the Colonel served in a scries of assignents in the Far East Theater with the G3 Section, IX Corps; Headquarters LFFE/8A (Rear); Joint Operetion Center, Jepen; and as hry reprosentative in the Theater Joint Operatiuns Centor.

Upon return to CONUS, Coloncl Bernes wes assigned to the 4 th Infontry Division at Fort Lewis, Washington, as Speciel issistent to Doputy Brigede Cormander. On 2 Januery 1958, he wes appointed Deputy Brigacie Comander, which position he hold until plecod on terporary duty as Doputy Chiof of Strfe, Exorcise Dry Hills.

The Colonel has be n awardod the Legion of itorit, the Bronze Ster Medol, the "ir Medel, Amy Correndstion Ribbon, end the French Croix do Guorre.
