

TRANSPORTATION FACTS

Yellowstone National Park is easily reached from any spot on the globe. The new extended tour bus season in 1966 will be May 6 through October 8.

A new airport opened in 1965 at West Yellowstone, Montana, has three flights daily. Air service is also available to Billings, Montana, and to Jackson and Cody, Wyoming.

Transcontinental bus lines serve Jackson and Cody, Wyoming; and Livingston and West Yellowstone, Montana. Connections are made with park tour buses at Gardiner, Silver Gate, and West Yellowstone, Montana; and Cody and Jackson Lake Lodge, Wyoming.

Yellowstone Park is served by three railroads, the Northern Pacific, Union Pacific, and Burlington Route.

And, of course, motorists may reach Yellowstone with ease on any major U.S. highway leading to the five entrances at Jackson and Cody, Wyoming; and Gardiner, Silver Gate, and West Yellowstone, Montana.

The Grand Loop Road of the Park, connects Mammoth Hot Springs with the geyser basins, Yellowstone Lake, Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone, and Tower Falls. Acknowledged to be one of the most magnificent scenic tours in America, it should be traveled leisurely, and completely. Motorists are cautioned to drive with exceptional care within the park as the natural wonders often distract both pedestrians and other motorists.

Package bus tours through the park may be arranged by contacting the entrance agents at (North Entrance, Mammoth Motor Inn; Northeast Entrance, Union Railway Depot, Billings, Montana; East Entrance, Green Gables Inn, Cody, Wyoming; South Entrance, Jackson Lake Lodge, Moran, Wyoming; and West Entrance, Menzel's Greyhound Depot or the Yellowstone Airport, West Yellowstone, Montana.)

During your stay in Yellowstone, enjoy the numerous side trips in and around the park. See numerous wild animals by taking the wild life tour which leaves Mammoth Motor Inn, Old Faithful Inn, and Lake Hotel each evening. Enjoy the historic mining town of Virginia City, Montana. Visit the earthquake area outside of West Yellowstone, Montana. Arrangements for any of these side tours, plus many more, are available at all locations in Yellowstone Park.
