Construction during fiscal year 1943 was confined to the Drop #2 power plant. It included installation of equipment, adjusting and testing of the electrical equipment and turbine and grading of the grounds.

Construction contemplated for fiscal year 1944 is to be limited to the completion of the Toppenish Creek pumping plant which will make it possible to supply water for all the land under Pumping Unit No. 2.
