Dear John W:

The Franklin Press passed on your letter of April 30,
inquiring about Strangers On the Land. (They are not a dealer).

The book was a tribal publication. I have a small supply of books
from the tribe for sale. It is 1.35 for 2.25 resale in orders of 2 or
more copies. I presume you've seen it. It runs around 63,000 words, illus.
and is footnoted but not indexed. Wraps. I also have a few copies of
the tribal publication, out of print, 1855-1955 The Yakima, wraps,
published in 1955. It is 1.20 for 2.00 re-sale.

The Franklin Press has no other publications. I understand that
Dr. Robert Ruby and John Brown (Moses Lake and Wenatchee) have mscpt.
on Chief Moses in hands of University of Oklahoma Press. It would be
an exhaustive work in that field.

Incidentally do you have Vol. II of Allen, History of the Expedition,
Lewis and Clark (Harper, 1868, family library). I have a Vol I and need
the Vol. II.

Incidentally, too, as you know Drummers and Dreamers is out of print and
I've seen it at \$12 to \$22.50. I didn't buy extra copies, as I should
have. If I hear of any "local publications" in the field you might be
interested in, I'll drop you a note.

The Franklin Press (printer) and not an agent, turned over your inquiry re: Strangers on the Land to me.

Copies of this Feb. 5, 1963 publication, now nearly out of print (and not to be re-issued) are \$2.25 for individual copies and \$1.35 each for two or more copies, mailed free.
