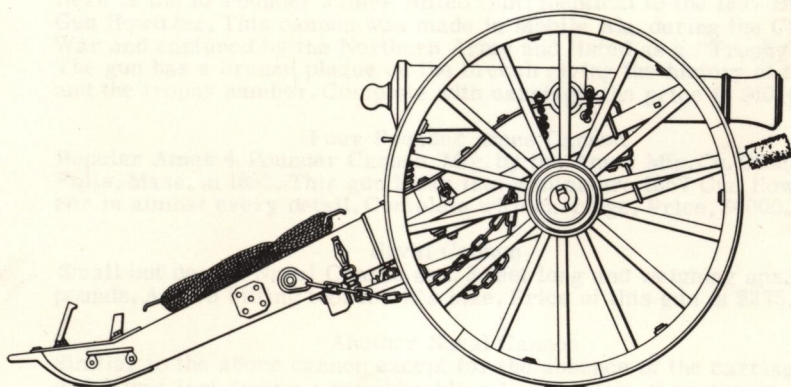

20 Pounder Parrot Gun

Philippino Gas Pipe Cannon

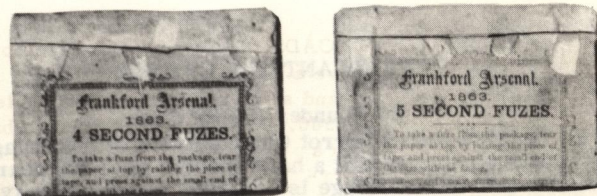

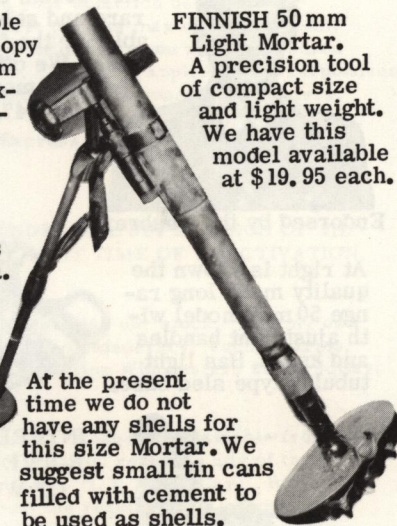

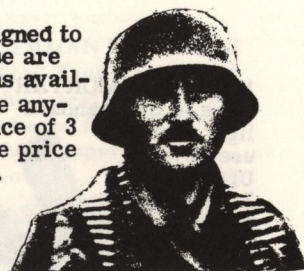

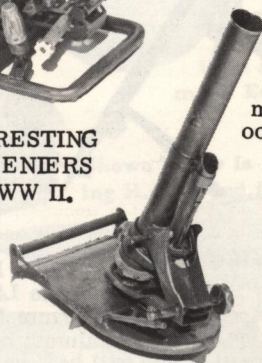
