She needs to know how they dressed and if they wore feather headdress (I think they did not). They are known as Nez Perce and wore ornamental shell in their pierced nose. They also had the Appaloosa horse.

They were a Nomadic people and fished and hunted around the Columbia River - right? I think they wore leather clothing - did they?

The Art teacher for Phyllis says the Squaw wore a skirt like the "grass skirt". I don't believe it cause it was cold in their country.

Will you send us typed or printed information and pictures of Buck + Squaw? and a picture of their Appaloosa horse. I'll inclose stamps and you let me know if you need money for the printed material and pictures - please don't charge too much.

We love every member of the entire Indian Nation - past, present and future. They trusted the paleface and lost their home, lands, + their ~~life~~ life.
