Sponsored by the Seattle Branch of the National League of American Pen Women, IN BEHALF OF AUTHORS IN THE FOUR PACIFIC NORTHWEST STATES AND ALASKA, this display will, in the course of time, constitute a complete history of books of this great region. The first book eligible in this special collection was written in 1834, over one hundred years ago.

Every book written by a Pacific Northwest author since that date should be included. Older books are not often obtainable from usual sources, and therefore a special plea is made to owners of private collections to

donate books. The donation will be properly acknowledged in arranging the exhibit.

ALL PACIFIC NORTHWEST AUTHORS SHOULD BE REPRESENTED. It is important to them today and in the future. With the exception of rare cases, only books published as bound volumes are acceptable.

The complete works of each individual author will be displayed as one unit, whenever possible. The author's publisher in many cases may aid in completing the exhibit.
