Gentlemen:

Could you please provide, in duplicate copy, a rough estimate for casting a high relief plaque, 27 x 29 inches: (no undercuts)

1-Bronze, finished with bosses.

2-Aluminum, finished.

3-Silica aluminum.

4-Your suggestion for a metal that would "harmonize" with an aluminum faced building.

5- Bronze or aluminum with two or three undercuts.

Also: add two or three remarks as to time required upon receipt of plaster cast, and a "very" rough estimate for carrying out a full figure, one third larger than life, and life from a scale model, permitting artist one or two weeks to "complete" the worked up enlargement before casting:

1-bronze

2-aluminum

3-your suggestion of metal

In regard to the latter, this is understood to be only a very rough estimate, based on works you have done and is only to "implant" the idea at this time with a potential customer. If the price is for the casting, only, from a model finished to size, please specify.
