In the event the end papers for Drummers and Dreamers have not been prepared for engraving, I believe your artist could insert the words Wanapum Dam to good advantage.

This is easily located.

At approximately the center is an Indian fan, a long house and a bell. The word Wanapums appears below the long house.

The words Wanapum Dam should be inserted to the right of the Columbia River just above Crab Creek and just below Vantage. Thus:

If it is too late, no harm done. But if not, it would be to the advantage of D and D. No acknowledgement necessary to save you time.
