Dear Sir:

Enclosed are additional typescripts of material on repository
in the Yakima Indian Agency Office at Toppenish, Washington.

It is being sent with the expectation that it may make the work
of the ethno-historians, working on the various claims cases, a bit
easier and less eye-straining. Moreover, I doubt that this material is
on file anywhere, excepting the Yakima Agency.

May I point out that while much of the material is of obvious
little value, there are occasional references to fisheries, customs,
tribes, people [individuals] schools, benefits paid Indians, etc. etc.
And, conceivably, some of this material could be of benefit to the
Department. I note several references to the Tumwater Fisheries.

It is obvious, too, that the Paiute material, herein
contained, is of no value since a complete file of Paiute material was
loaned and has been returned. I however include it, along with
all other material copied.

May I note that this type of material is available to attorneys
and those visiting the Yakima office only, and while they have undoubtedly
spent much time looking over the files, I am sure they have no complete
copies like the attached, nor have they spent as much time in scanning.
