
Logy Creek Cattle Association is holding its Tenth Annual Bull Grading Tour Wednesday, March 1. We hope you will be able to attend.

The Bull Grading Tour will start at John Newquist's place on Newquist Road, south of the Satus Store. The grading of bulls will start at 9:30 a.m. Official Judge will be Dr. Gene Hoehne, Extension Livestock Specialist, Washington State University.

- 1st Stop - John Newquist -- Newquist Road
- 2nd Stop - George Foster -- Corner of Foster Road and Newquist Road
- 3rd Stop - Tim Foster -- Foster Road
- 4th Stop - Chuck Ray -- Foster Road

11:30 a.m. Lunch and noontime program -- Alfalfa Grange Hall  
Bring a sack lunch. The Logy Creek Cattle Association will furnish coffee.

Dr. Roy Hostetler, Extension Animal Health Specialist, Washington State University, will talk on "Diseases of Range Cattle". Dr. Gene Hoehne will discuss "Feeding the Range Herd", and Ed Reif, County Agent, will report on the "Steer of Merit Program".

-- 1/2 mile south of Jensen Road on Old Goldendale Road (Three Bridges Road) and 1/4 mile west
- 10th Stop - George Jensen-- Old Goldendale Road near Toppenish Creek, east of road. (New Corral)
