Dear Cull:

Sounds like you've been doing a little work on the Historical Society.

My appearance at Richland is Thursday, the 18th. We will leave after that for Ephrata. And will have all day Friday in Ephrata so will be at the 6:30 p.m. dinner. I will write Chapin Foster, our director, and see if he has any message he wishes relayed, or it may be Ken Odlin might have a message to pass on. He is our president.

I will give Ken additional material or provide some material for a story later as it shapes up.

I am rushed, but I am getting through with it, I think.

Our tour will also be a memorial

for the dead leader.
