Library program to open

"Button Club" is the theme of this year's summer reading program sponsored by the Yakima Valley Regional Library. Beginning June 8, the six-week program will end Saturday, July 20, at 6:00 p. m.

Mrs. Connie Ryan, Wapato librarian; Mrs. Eileen Rosenfelt, White Swan librarian; and Mrs. Fay Schanz, Harrah librarian, invite children of their areas to participate in the program.

Any child who has completed the first grade is eligible to participate in the program. There is no upper grade limit. The child may participate through the main library in Yakima, the various bookmobile stops, and the 16 community libraries.

Beginning June 8, children may ask for a booklet providing spaces to record the books they have read. The parent must sign the booklet before credit is given. When the reader has completed his six books, he will receive a bright orange button with "I'm For Books" inscribed in white upon it. In the fall he will receive a reading club certificate at his school.
