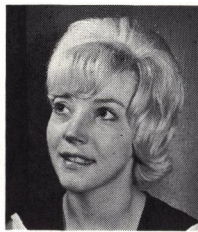

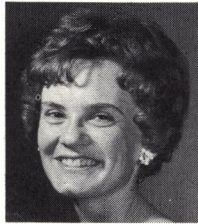
### 9 CAROLE ANN ACKERMAN

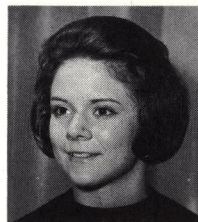
### 11 SHERRY ANN LITZENBERGER

### 4 PAMELA LEE SHEA

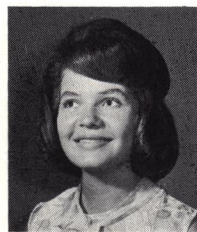
