INTRODUCTION

This exhibition of paintings from the Cosla Collection presents a grouping of Biblical events and characters as interpreted by many of the leading masters of the European schools from the 15th to the 19th centuries, and has been loaned by the Maryhill Museum of Fine Arts, Maryhill, Washington. Dr. O. K. Cosla and his wife Rose are the owners of the Cosla Collection, which had its start in 1760 when Ana de Clerici, who married William K. Cosla, brought as part of her dowry a fine group of Italian and Spanish paintings. Since then each succeeding generation of the Cosla family with fine appreciation and discernment has added paintings to the collection, thus maintaining it as one of the foremost of its kind.

Dr. O. K. Cosla was Professor of Medicine on the faculty of the University of Bucharest, Roumania for many years prior to 1948 and also connected with universities in Berlin and Strasbourg. In 1948 he became Associate Professor at the University of Minnesota and, later, was on the faculty of the College of the Ozarks, Arkansas, prior to establishing himself as a physician in New York City in 1951. He is a fellow of the Academy of Medicine, Academy of Science, College of Cardiology, College of Angiology, and other medical and scientific groups. He is also on the staff of Polyclinic Hospital.

In 1936 the widely known authority on art, Leo Van Puy-Velde, Professor at the University of Brussels and Chief Conservator of the Mus'es Royaux des Beau-Arts de Belgique, wrote in a preface to a catalog of the Cosla Collection: "One likes to stray in this treasure of art....famous masters come to mind and their names to your lips." Over the years the collection has traveled from country to country in Europe and in this country has been on exhibition at Sacramento, California at the Crocker State Art Gallery; the Museum of Fine Arts, Little Rock, Arkansas; Maryhill Museum of Fine Arts at Maryhill, Washington; Museum of Fine Arts at Oakland, California; Mills College at El Paso, Texas; College of Mines at Boise, Idaho and Museum of Fine Arts at Portland, Oregon.

The American Bible Society extends its sincere thanks to Dr. and Mrs. Cosla for their graciousness in making it possible for us to show these paintings of the Cosla Collection.
