



This is an historic building. Here Park College was born. For more than fifteen years through toil, hardships and poverty it

April 12th, 1875 Dr. and Ars. McAfee, with seventeen students entered upon the work of converting the building into a Home and College building. May 12th, 1875 the first recitations were held. As rapidly as rooms could be fitted up the number of students increased. The picture is reproduced from a faded photograph taken in 1882. It represents all there was of Park College at that time. This building with one hundred acres of land, donated by Col. Geo. S. Park, constituted the entire property and endowment after seven years of hard work.
