1 AN ACT Relating to public highways; authorizing and directing the
2 state highway commission to make a feasibility study of
3 adding a highway from the Lewis River to the Yakima area
4 to the state highway system; and making an appropriation.
5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
6 NEW SECTION. Section 1. The Washington state highway com-
7 mission is hereby authorized and directed to make, or cause to be
8 made, a study of the feasibility and need of adding to the state
9 highway system a highway commencing from SSH No. 1-S in the vicinity
10 of the Lewis River and Yale northeasterly to an intersection with
11 PSH No. 3 in the Yakima area.
12 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the motor
13 vehicle fund to the Washington state highway commission the sum of
14 one hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as shall be neces-
15 sary, to finance this study.
