Bert Wallace, King County Chairman of the Conservative Party and his organization will host a state-wide convention on Saturday, December 2, 1967 at the Colonial Manor, 7th and Blanchard, Seattle, Washington. Doors will be open at 12:00 Noon.

The Wallace for President forces within the Conservative Party will make a progress report, and will ask the party members for official support of George Wallace in the hopes of having his name on every ballot in Washington State at the 1968 elections.
