League of Professional Groups for Foster & Ford (Actual Communist group - not just a Commie Front - see pages 529, 985, 1000, 1483, of Index IX. Foster and Ford were known Communists, running on Communist Party Ticket for President and Vice President in early 30's.)

Committee of 100 in Support of NAACP Legal Defense & Educational Fund, Inc. (This in 1960, 1963, 1964  
led by Communist W. E. B. DuBois.)

National Committee to Aid Striking Miners Fighting Starvation (Sid should oughta know no work no eat . . . but let's give him credit for being all heart anyway.)

Signed petition to President Kennedy asking pardon for Communist Party leader Junius Scales of North Carolina.

# Conor Cruise O'Brien

(Alias Donat O'Donnell)

Remember the Congo? In case you don't, in 1960 the United Nations forced the Congo into "Independence" from Belgium and put in Patrice Lumumba, a Communist terrorist and cannibal as Prime Minister. Lumumba opened his doors to Russian "technicians" immediately, and as in all Communist take-overs, the killing, rape and bloodshed in general turned the country into absolute chaos overnight. One province of the Congo, that of Katanga, under Moise Tshombe, seceded from the chaos that was the Congo. The United Nations then sent in troops, aided and supplied by the United States. These UN troops (according to Red Cross officials who can hardly be accused of being politically biased) butchered helpless patients in their hospital beds, literally shot up and raped the civilian population of both Europeans and Africans at will, and installed a Communist government over the Katanga people. One of the end results of this UN action in the Congo was the Stanleyville Massacre.

Where was Conor during most of this butchery and treachery? At the center of UN Command where he was directly responsible for what happened in the Congo.

For an excellent summary of his sinister role in the Katanga invasion, see USA, Sept. 3-17, 1965, pages 3-4. O'Brien's deputy in Katanga was known to be a Communist by our security people at the time. Conor resigned from the UN in December of 1961, and took over as Vice-Chancellor at the University of Ghana until 1965. During this time he worked for Nkrumah, another Communist from Africa.

Conor attacks our Vietnam position and protests along with the Berkeley crowd.

Conor instructs at New York's "Free School" (which is another "Free University" fraud.)

Conor participates in the "Conference of Socialist Scholars."

Conor says he resigned from the UN, but went right into close working arrangements with Communist Nkrumah.

Conor is just another Socialist, selling Socialism.

I doubt that the Eichmann trial was "in the profoundest sense, theatre." I doubt that Christianity is either "Popular Platonism" or an essentially romantic religion. I doubt that a movie depicting in detail highly variegated sexual activities can be "childlike and witty" . . . I doubt that the Judeo-Christian God has been killed stone dead."

Susan is just another of the Leftist followers of "Camp" . . . and it's pretty obvious to anyone reading her stuff. She is obviously a devotee of both Sartre and Nietzsche, (whose philosophy is certainly leftist to say the very least) and if one were to look into her associates one would find:

# John Dyckman

## Master Planner from Berkeley

Perhaps the best description of what Mr. Dyckman is proposing is to explain what brand of Socialism the planners have in mind when they talk about "Regional development", Urban Renewal, and "Metropolitan Government."

"Regional Government" or "Development" is to follow a plan laid down by the Socialists who came to power with FDR. The Urban Renewal and Metro-Governments are merely parts of the overall scheme to finish off the American Free Enterprise system with our local governments, and to replace them with "Regional" governments run by Washington, D.C. appointees. Hence, you see "mergers" and consolidations of school districts, fire districts, county governments, city and town governments, etc., going on all around you. The end result of merging is to eventually abolish all state lines and have five big "Provinces", "Regions", or "Soviets" as the only government in the USA. The first of these regions are already in place . . . they are called "Appalachia" and "Tennessee Valley".

Though the above may startle you, and appear to be some wild dream cooked up by "Radicals", one can ascertain the validity of the claim by studying the very documents put out by the various organizations listed in the "1313" grouping on the opposite page. The planners are quite bold, for their proposals are made with the knowledge that most people will never take the trouble to check out their fine print, and, once they have their "Plans" in place, it is usually too late to protest.

Dyckman may or may not have ulterior motives . . . frankly, the motives are of little consequence when Socialism is the weapon. Some 4,000 years of recorded history prove that Socialism is the frequent result of men turning to themselves for guidance and moral standards. Socialism always enslaves men to a master plan (created by the planners) . . . never creates anything but discord and social malpractice. The wonderful dream worlds of socialists do not exist in reality because of mankind's inability to live peacefully together. When men realize that living together peacefully is a responsibility which God leaves up to each individual, they will stop trying to legislate human decency; until then, we shall be plagued with men like the planner Dyckman, who is just another Socialist.



# This Is Metro

"Metropolitan Government" has become part of a pincers movement which can destroy the whole fabric of government and social organization in the United States — eliminate the sovereign states as meaningful political entities, and divide the nation into metropolitan regions (or soviets) managed by appointed experts, who will be answerable primarily to the supreme soviet in Washington, which will provide most of the tax money.

At the top of this pincers movement is the drive for world government; at the bottom is "Metropolitan Government."

## BRIEF HISTORY OF EXPERTISM

The National Municipal League was organized in 1894, headquarters in New York, to fight graft and corruption in municipal governments. By 1915, the National Municipal League (although never saying so bluntly) had given up any idea of reforming city governments. In 1915, the League started agitation for city governments by appointed experts — called city managers.

By 1931, the National Municipal League had become quite militant in pushing the city managership idea.

The League's basic idea — of executive government by appointed experts, with elected officials performing ceremonial roles and exercising the perfunctory duty of approving and raising funds for the city managers' schemes — triumphed marvelously in 1933 when Roosevelt instituted the same sort of system for the national government.

In April, 1938, the University of Chicago completed, at 1313 East 60th Street, a building to house organizations devoted to the hatching of schemes for re-making America. Today, 1313 East 60th Street is the national headquarters for 22 organizations most of which have interlocking directorates, and most of which are tax-exempt outfits financed by tax-free foundations (like Rockefeller, Carnegie, Julius Rosenwald, Russell Sage, Ford).

Thus, 1313 East 60th Street, Chicago, has become a national center for the production of experts — to fabricate "progressive" legislation for governments at all levels, to rewrite our "archaic" state constitutions (the Ford Foundation was underwriting this project) and to take over as city managers or county managers, or metropolitan managers, or regional managers whenever people in any locality have progressed to the point of accepting government by imported experts as a substitute for government by elected local citizens.

Behind the individual experts, understandably dedicated to the idea of government-by-experts, is the web of planners and schemers at 1313 East 60th Street, Chicago, who have a vision of a new kind of America: in which the old federation of sovereign states, held together in union by a central government of carefully limited powers, will be changed for a nation divided into a score of urban-rural (or metropolitan) areas, which sprawl across forgotten and meaningless state boundary lines. Each area will be managed by an appointed expert.

## 'HOME RULE'

State governments create counties and grant charters for towns and cities. Before these state-authorized entities can be abolished or consolidated into one, the state must grant permission.

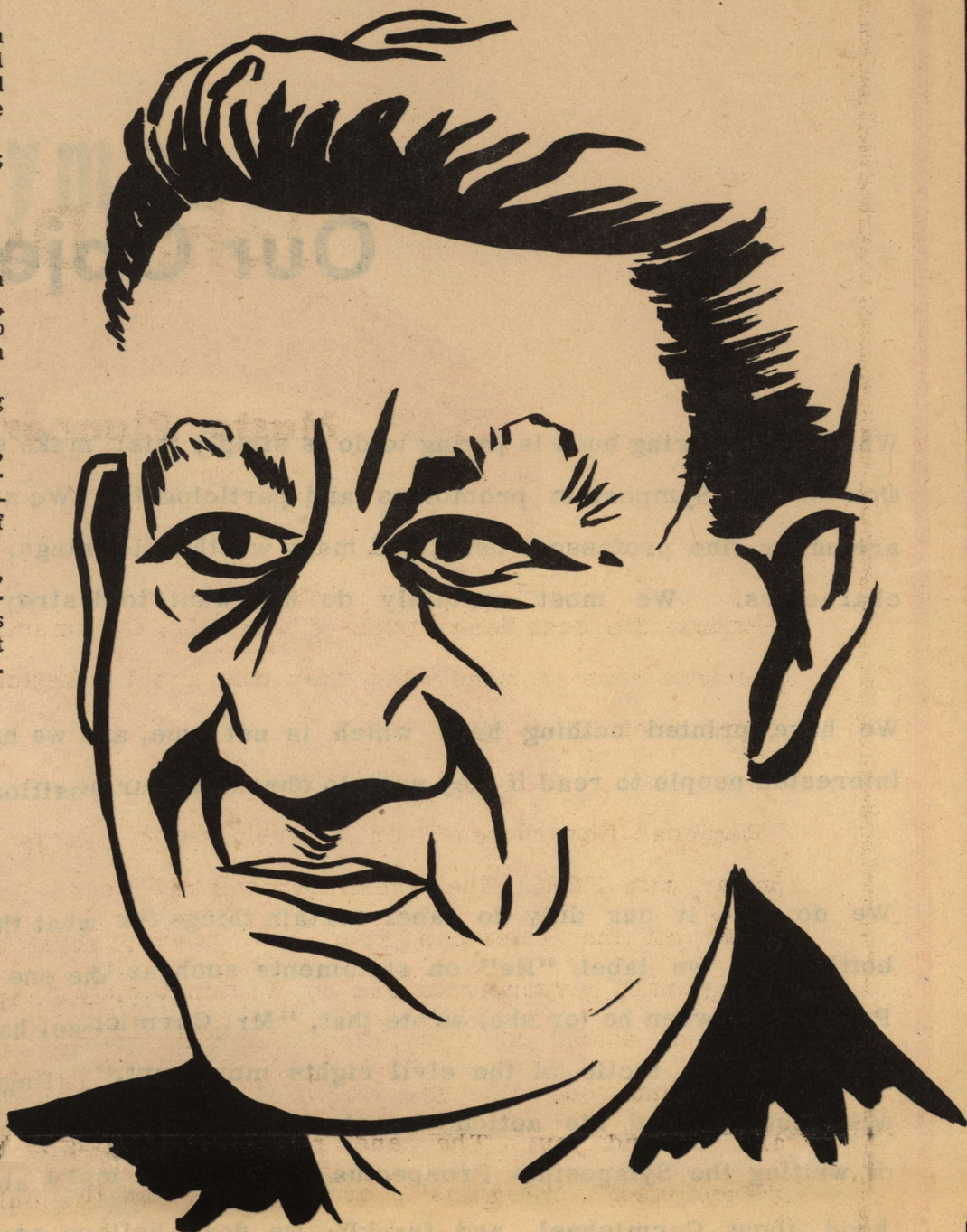
That calls for lobbying at the state capital — which necessitates whipping up local sentiment to support the lobby. The argument to swing this is generally "home rule." Why can't we, a progressive community of Americans, have home rule — rule ourselves as we see fit? Why must we be beholden to the state capital for every change we want to make in our home government? Let us have a home rule charter.

But home rule never brings rule by elected home folks. It brings rule by appointed experts over whom taxpayers and voters have no direct control, very little indirect control.

## IT HAS BEEN TRIED

Metro is not new. It has been tried in Dade County, Florida and Nashville, Tennessee, to name just two instances. Like most socialistic schemes, only 11% of the qualified voters in Dade County voted for Metro, and yet it passed and became law. (Now they wish they'd gone to the polls to vote.)

The Metro Charter was hardly adopted before citizens in Dade County found they had voted themselves into super-government beyond their control. Officials of the 26 separate municipalities in Dade County had accepted assurances that their communities would not lose self-government. Almost immediately, however, the new Board of Commissioners started passing ordinances which eliminated self-government in the county. Instances of corruption, favoritism, waste, and other evils attributed to Metro, became apparent shortly after the new government was formed.

People found that instead of reduced taxes through "more efficient government" they had more irresponsible spending of public money — and more governmental harassment: for example, in some Dade County communities, citizens were required to have TWO safety stickers on their car: one for the municipal government, one for Metro.

## TO KILL AN OCTOPUS

People can fight tentacles of the metropolitan-government octopus at the local level, by opposing urban renewal projects and Metro schemes. But only the U. S. Congress can destroy the monster — by withholding the federal tax money which feeds it.

ENOUGH pressure from a well-informed public could persuade Congress to stop all federal interference in the affairs of our cities.
