General Orders No. 6 - YAK - 1954.

To All Cannoneers, Yakima and Inland Empire Unit.

6 March, 1954, 1900 hours. Assemble Chinook Hotel, Yakima. Plans and briefing for Haller Cannon Search. Examination of witnesses, government documents and maps.

7 March, 1954, 0630 hours. Assemble Chinook Hotel, Yakima, in field clothes, equipped with location and recovery instruments.

1000 hours. Move out in convoy.
Destination, Haller Battle Ground, via White Swan.

1100 hours. Rendezvous with Yakima
Indian guides, White Swan Long House.

1130 hours. Search Haller Battle Ground
and environs for howitzer abandoned by End U.S. Infantry
on October 8, 1855.

1330 hours. Move operations to Fort
Simcoe. Search for cannon reported buried near or
under chapel, 1859.

1530 hours. Return to Chinook Hotel,
Yakima, for resume of action and appraisal of results.
