

PURPOSE

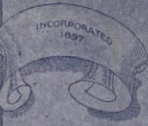
