ARTICLE III OF THE CONSTITUTION.

Section 1. Any girl under eighteen years or boy under twenty-one years of age may be eligible for membership in this Society who is lineally descended from a man or woman who with unfailing loyalty rendered material aid to the cause of American Independence as a soldier, sailor, civil officer, or recognized patriot in one of the several Colonies or States or of the United Colonies or States.
