Notice is hereby given of a meeting of the Washington State Power Commission at 2:00 P. M., Monday, November 8, 1954, in Pasco, Washington, at the Auditorium of the Franklin County Public Utility District.

While this is a regular meeting of the Commission, it will give an opportunity for people in the area to become familiar with the program of the Commission regarding power development in the State in general, as well as affecting the particular interest of the Tri-City area in the Priest Rapids development.
