Mr. MAGNUSON (for himself and Mr. JACKSON) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Interior and
Insular Affairs

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to establish, in the
State of Washington, an institution for the care, custody,
and education of certain juvenile dependents and delinquents.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior is authorized and directed
4 to establish, in the State of Washington, an institution for
5 the care, custody, and education of juvenile dependents and
6 delinquents within the jurisdiction of any tribal or United
7 States court.

8 SEC. 2. Such institution established pursuant to the pro-
9 visions of the first section of this Act shall be operated and

1 maintained by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to such
2 rules and regulations as he may provide.

3 SEC. 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated,
4 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
5 such sums as may be necessary to carry out the provisions
6 of this Act.
