This is year of dates. Celebrating return trip of Lewis & Clark- 150 years ago; the Fort Simcoe centennial and we could well celebrate a few Yakima birthdays, too.

Look back to Jan.18,1803. That was year Thomas Jefferson asked congress for \$2,500 to finance a "litery expedition" across continent to unknown lands of west. First time in history of nation anyone ever thought of such a thing as literary expedition-propably only such expedition xxxxxxxxx ever financed by any nation.

Took two years before exped tion got off, one year to get to coast another to return to St.Louis.Most of 43 men on trip were like Johnny; they couldn't spell, even Capts.Clark and Lewis couldn't but all of them put in spare time writing this and that.

Typical- Capt. Lewis and rattlesnake.

Yakima born, Feb. 4, 1855. Plat filed in SPaul.

Fight over by city- lots offered all who move. Plans made- good thing not started 2 years earlier when temperature 40 below. Ice and snow found under rocks on river bank at July 4 picnic.

Town moved in May- mule teams- Shadbolt, Gilland House, bank, Centennial Hall. In year, from dust to 1000 population. Big spectacle- last chance.

1889- fight for tstate capital-Congdon deeded land-now site new junior and senior high schools.

Planning began long before expedition off, before Revolution when Jefferson talked to his friends about need for going to west coast. He had as his secretary- that in 1801- Meriweather Lewis.

When Jefferson became president, remembered need of exploring land to west. Russians sent Vitus Bering down coast-Robert Gray told of Columbia-Congress appropriated \$2,500 for "literary and scientific expedition. Lewis took lead, pentagon of day kept Clark as lieutenanet but called captain. Given co honors all way from Mi souri to Pasific-not a quarrel. First camping place as expedition gather d across river from St. Louis-43 in that group- a dozen to go part way and then back with reports, 31 soldiers.

On way-Sgt. Floyd died. Test of democracy. **xp**xinsxhexd Led to first election in west. Captains nominated three for promotion, men elected haming Gass.

On Nov.2,1805, camped at

Ft. Mandan-busy with preparations river trip. There expedition met Sacajawea, name byword, statues erected ,one splendid one at Portland. Her husband, guide Toussaint Charbanneau was hired as interpreter and Sacajawea, one of his three wives, went as guidenexexx interpreter. Had been won by Charbanneau in gamble, had earlier been captured and taken from her own people, Shoshones.

Lucky choice. Even when wadnestappadxbyx handicapped by carrying baby ,named Paptists, kept the pace. Clark always called baby Pomp-Shoshone word. Etc.

Expedition, which build boats, rafts, etc, during winter, In April,

Sacajawea ill. Dosed with Epsom salts, opium, sulfnr, etch-bark poultices.

Thermometer-made from Anything else had. She recovered in self preservation.

mercury on **Exx** mirror.

Tough going-men dragged boats. One stage, 10 days to make 18 milesbut these were young men and could still sing. On August finally made contact with Shoshones-Sacajawea and brother Cameahwait reunionted.

Got to Pacific- saw whale.Built F#sClatsop-everyone went on writing and studying land and poeple.

On Mar.23 broke camp and moved on. Plan for party to separate and join at St, Louis, On way back-episode of "the book"/ At camp at base of Lolo Pass, Clark been called on to dose Indians. Got idea that Clark's black

Bible was strong medicine-cured many and when, 25 years later, another epidemic tribe sent two Indians to St. Louis to ask for "the book"-thinking it a cure. That request led to Jason Lee, Marcus Whitman, De met coming west.

Expediti n back in Mandan in Augustul806. Capt. Lewis wounded by one of menethought he was elk. Grizzly bears-bad. Rattler sleeping with one of captains at foot of tree-killed it and then made careful notes for his

"literary" part of effort.Bittermoot adventure, At mouth of Yakima, so many ducks, ggede etc, noise horrid.

Captains led out 31 maxx young men,/came back seasoned explorers in much better makax health than when they left. No other exploring party equaled it- economy, high adventure, results.
