Vacations

Two weeks vacation with pay during June, July, or August to those who were employed before July 1 of the previous year, one week if employed between July 1 of the previous year and January 1 of this year. . . .

Medical Assistance

Employes of the Republic Publishing Co. are members of the Yakima Medical Association and the Blue Cross Hospital plan. This service is paid for by our employer and assures each employe of the best medical attention without cost. This protection is also available to our families at a reasonable cost to us. . . .

Life Insurance

A free life insurance policy for every member of our team. Each employe receives a \$500 policy after completing six months employment. After one year the policy increases to \$1,000, in five years to \$1500, and after ten years to \$2,000. . . .

Accident Insurance

Upon completion of six months employment, each employe is insured under an accident and sickness policy. This policy pays 60 per cent (30 per cent if covered by workmen's compensation) of our salary after the third day of illness for a period of thirteen weeks. This policy also pays \$1,000 for loss of life, hands, feet, or eyes as the result of an accident. . . .

Sick-Leave

Employes accumulate sick-leave at the rate of one-half day per month. Maximum accruable is 66 days. This supplements the accident and health insurance plan and assures us of one hundred per cent of our salary as long as sick-leave benefits exist. . . .

Bonus

Our team won! . . . The teamwork and loyalty of each individual member of our organization has enabled our employer to pay a substantial year-end bonus to each of us for the last five years. . . .
