As to the identification, the two drum beaters are (from left)
Toy-Toy (unable to get first name) and Tom Joe; Goerge Spino, next, ringing bells.
Unable to identify man with shovel, but don't believe he was particularly significant. To left of shoveler's head is John Abraham and to his left Sam Sturgis of Corville reservation, Wash.

I am enclosing my own poor attempt at reporting what transpired at the funeral. It won't be nearly as specific as you would like because I got to the funeral late and had to catch the whole business within a few minutes. I saw no mats in evidence. I had no earlier shot of procession.
